# **APEX Print Report Dialog plugin**

## License

The plugin has been developed by the J4L FO Designer team (<u>http://www.apex-reports.com/</u>) and will work with any report. It is a free component.

#### Introduction

This plugin will create a Report Dialog for the APEX print reports.

If your print server needs a few seconds to generate the PDF print report, the dialog will provide user rich experience while waiting for the server response.

The dialog can be closed using the ESC button or clicking on the close icon. In this case the report request will be ignored.

### **Import plugin**

Import the file *item\_type\_plugin\_printreportdialog.sql* with the option:

application -> shared components -> plug-ins -> import


The example is based on the APEX Sample application. You can of course use your own report.

Enter the attributes of the plug-in:

- Report URL: enter the URL of the print report or report query. Please note the report must be an *inline* report (not *attachment* type). If you select the attachment type, the dialog window will need to be closed manually by the user.
- Dialog title: Enter the title of the print dialog window.
- Dialog first line: Enter the first line of the print dialog.
- Dialog second line: Enter the second line of the print dialog.
- Button label: Enter the label of the print button.
